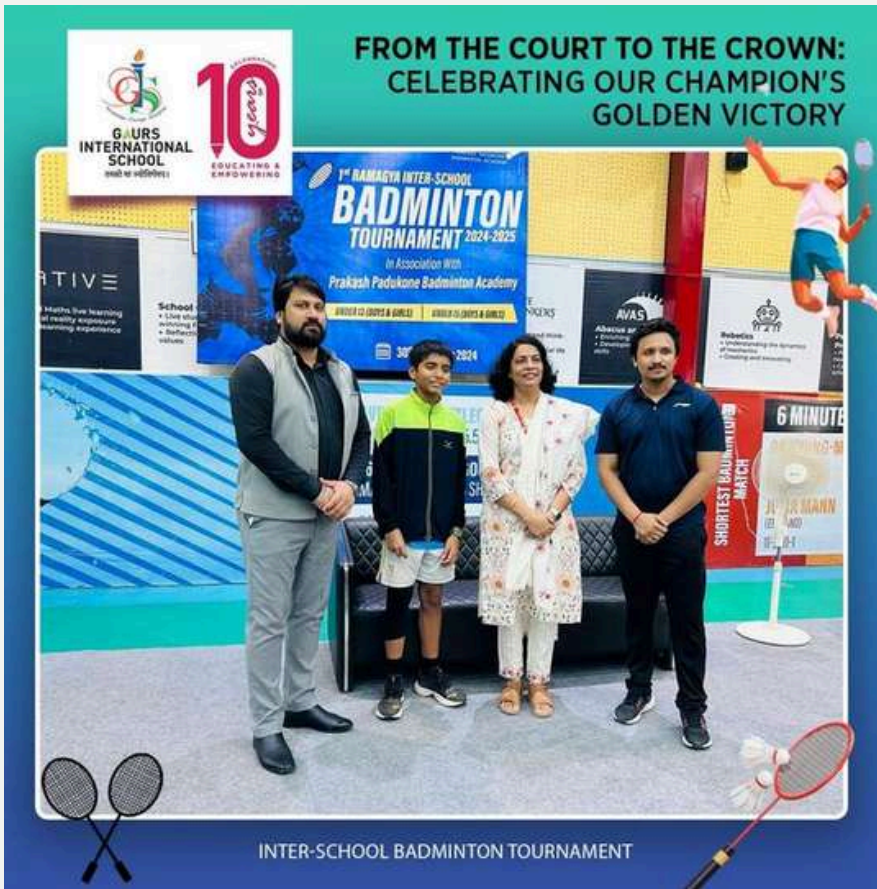
IMPORTANT REMINDERS
